2. INFORMATION TO BIDDERS

1. Background

Roots of Peace (ROP) is a humanitarian organization whose mission is to rid the world of landmines and other remnants of war by transforming toxic minefields into thriving farmland and communities through a focus on sustainable, organic farming practices. Roots of Peace is implementing a Community-Based Agriculture Rural Development (CBARD) project to support the Production of Fruits and Vegetables as an alternative to poppy Cultivation and Trade in five high Cultivation provinces of Afghanistan.

Moreover, the ROP-CBARD project aims to create partnerships between existing ROP-CBARD communities to reach three key objectives: reducing opium poppy cultivation, creating alternative licit economic development for former poppy farmers and women in the community, and supporting more sustainable peace.

2. Reporting on Fraud, Anti-corruption, and exploitation

		2. The source, origin, and nationality of the goods are not from a Prohibited Country, nor have they been transported through such a country.
		3. Having adequate financial resources to deliver goods.
		4. Ability to comply with required or proposed delivery/performance schedules.
		5. Have a satisfactory past performance record.
		6. Have a satisfactory record of integrity and business ethics.
		7. Be qualified, and eligible to perform work under the laws and regulations of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan, UNDP, and/or ROP.

4. EVALUATION AND AWARD

An award will be made based on the Lowest Price, Technically Acceptable source selection process. The award will be issued to the responsible Offeror submitting the lowest evaluated price that follows the RFQ instructions and meets or exceeds the acceptability requirements for technical requirements described in this RFQ.

ROP-CBARD will evaluate the following factors as PASS/FAIL:

- Technical specifications fully meet or exceed the requirements (provide detailed specifications with brand names and model numbers).
- Delivery time: no more than seven calendar days after the day of signing the contract.
- Delivery terms: DAP Kabul, CBARD main office.
- Warranty: minimum 24 months seller warranty on all items. The vendor should agree to the Standard Warranty Terms provided in Annex 3.
- Complete business information and a valid business license (Annex 2b).
- At least three successful contracts of similar nature and complexity (e.g., contracts with international NGOs). Fill out the Past Performance form in Annex 2c.
- Proposal validity period of 60 days (Annex 2a).

Standard Warranty Terms

1. Seller guarantees the product purchased by the Buyer to be free from defects resulting from the use of faulty parts or poor workmanship during its manufacture subject to terms of the limited warranty ("warranty") given below:

- a) The claim will have to be made within the warranty period.
- b) Seller will repair or replace any defective parts and correct any problems resulting from poor workmanship free of charge. Seller reserves the right to use reconditioned parts with performance parameters equal to those of new parts in connection with any services performed under Seller's limited warranty.

2. Seller's warranty service

- a) Onsite service will be limited to the customer location, which is within Kabul or as per the specific customer SLA defined with the Seller.
- b) Based on the nature of the problem, the Seller can also provide tele-support to resolve the problem reported.

4. Seller's service level

- a) Response time Next Business Day
- b) Resolution time Five Business Days on a best effort basis
- c) Business hours 0900 hrs. to 1730 hrs.
- d) Business days Sunday to Friday (Except Public Holidays)

5. This warranty shall be rendered null & void if:

- a) The product is physically damaged.
- b) The product is modified, maintained, or repaired by a party not authorized by the Seller.
- c) The product is installed, maintained, and operated in ways other than as recommended by the Seller.
- d) The product is faulty or damaged due to electrical faults external to the equipment.
- e) The model number, serial number, or warranty stickers have been removed or tampered with.

6. Warranty Limitations

- a) The warranty is not transferable from one user/customer to another.
- b) The warranty does not cover the replacement of the equipment.
- c) Seller will not be responsible for loss of data on the PC under any circumstances. Customers are encouraged to back up all data stored on the hard disk of their Seller PC before giving the PC for service.
- d) Any software that accompanied the Seller PC is on an "as is" basis. Seller does not warrant the operation of any or all the software programs pre-loaded or added to the Seller's PC.
- e) Seller's warranty does not entail a warranty of functionality or any obligation to repair or replace defective equipment, if that defect is a result of physical breakage, improper installation or connections, electrical faults external to the product, software-induced problems (e.g. virus attacks), abuse or unauthorized modification of the product.
- f) Any service, repair, or replacement not within the scope of Seller's coverage shall be subject to the rates and terms of the Seller performing such service.
- g) Warranty on the lamp is restricted to 90 days only
- h) Seller does not warrant error-free or uninterrupted operation of the equipment.

7. Warranty does not apply to

- a) Cracked glass panel on the monitor, LCD screen, or damage caused by too much pressure exerted on the LCD.
- b) Plastic parts
- c) Defects or damage caused due to virus attack
- d) Parts requiring replacement due to normal wear and tear, corrosion, rust, stain, etc.,
- e) Damage or loss of any programs, data, or removable storage media including any consequential loss or damage
- f) Damages caused due to acts of God & force majeure.

8. Except for the warranties set forth herein, Seller disclaims all other warranties, express or implied or statutory, including, but not limited to the implied warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Any implied warranties that may be imposed by applicable law are limited to the duration of this limited warranty. In no event shall Seller be liable for any incidental, special, or consequential damages, consequential human injury, or loss, including, but not limited to loss of business, profits, data, or use whether in an action in contract or tort or based on a warranty arising out of or in connection with the use or performance of the product or any Seller supplied software which accompanies the product even if Seller has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

9. The customer agrees that repair or replacement, as applicable, under the warranty services described herein, are the sole and exclusive remedies with respect to any breach of the Seller limited warranty set forth herein.
