1. INTRODUCTION

2. BACKGROUND

2.1. Nature of Business

GAAC Holding is a subsidiary of Afroport Airport LLC registered in UAE. GAAC holding is registered with Government of Afghanistan. It has two concession agreements with the Government of Afghanistan. First contract is for the provision of ground handling services in three airports of Afghanistan and second agreement is for provision of Aviation Security Services in four airports of Afghanistan.

2.2. Governance Structure

GAAC holding is the subsidiary of Afroport Airport LLC. It has main office in Afghanistan led by a Regional Director. It has two contracts:

- a) Ground Handling
- b) Aviation security
- a) Ground Handling: For ground handling along with operations unit there is a support unit. It is providing ground handling services in three major airports inside the country that are Kabul, Kandahar, and Herat. These services are rendered based on concession agreement.
- b) Aviation Security Services: From 02 June 2022, GAAC is providing aviation security services in four major airports of Afghanistan that are Kabul, Kandahar, Mazar and Herat based on concession agreement signed on 02 June 2022.

2.4. Financial reporting framework and systems

The Company prepares its financial statements using International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs) and the presentation currency is Afghani (AFN) (AED) & (USD). It currently uses D365 Software and Lenok system to process and maintain its accounting records. The payroll is processed using D365 system. The Company's accounting transactions are not complex.

3. SCOPE OF THE PROPOSED EXTERNAL AUDITOR'S WORK

The scope of the External Auditors work shall include the following:



- 1. Conducting an Independent annual audit in accordance with International Auditing Standards and International Financial Reporting Standards for the following
 - GAAC Holding company for the full FY 2022
 - Ground Handling Contract from inception of contract till end of year 2022
 - Aviation Security Contract from inception of contract till end of year 2022
- Expressing an Opinion on whether the financial statements are prepared in all material respects, in accordance with the applicable financial reporting standards and frameworks, whether the Company has maintained proper accounting records, and whether the accompanying financial statements show a true and fair view of the Company's financial position.
- 3. Reviewing and evaluating the Company's Internal control and advising GAAC and MoTA on adequacy and effectiveness of the systems
- 4. Providing any value addition services consistent with a statutory audit of this nature of an organization.

4. MANDATORY CRITERIA

Bidding firms will be required to meet the following criteria

- 1. Be registered with the Government of Afghanistan.
- 2. Must be in operation in Afghanistan for the last 8 years
- 3. Must have a combined annual revenue of 800,000 in the last 3 years.
- 4. Must submit audit reports for the last 3 years i.e. 2019, 2020 and 2021.
- 5. Must provide tax clearance certificate for 2021 and updated AISA license.
- 6. Must be listed on the list of forum of firms of IFAC, and be one of the top 10 audit firms worldwide.
- 7. Should demonstrate that it has the capacity, capability and experience required for a thorough and fair audit

5. PROPOSAL SUBMISSION

5.1. Timelines

All proposals should be submitted by Thursday, 30 November 2022 COB.

5.2. Format

The proposal must contain both Technical and Financial proposals as follows:

5.2.1. Technical Proposal

- 1. Confirmation of the Firm's understanding of the Terms of Reference and its capacity and capability to deliver on the Terms of Reference
- 2. Capability of the proposed engagement of Audit team (Include CVs)
- Proposed Audit Strategy and Methodology



4. Proposed Audit work plan, timelines for undertaking the assignment and the deliverables

5.2.2. Financial Proposal

- 1. Audit Fees in USDs clearly indicating the charge out rate for the Audit team
- 2. An estimate of all disbursements
- 3. Audit Fee payment terms

5.2.3. Other Information

- 1. Proof of Registration with Government of Afghanistan.
- 2. Confirmation that neither the Firm nor key staff have faced disciplinary action with Government of Afghanistan.
- 3. References from three reputable clients with contact details of the Client officers providing the references
- 4. Declaration that there is no Conflict of Interest by the Firm or any member of the proposed Audit team to carry out the audit.
- 5. Include any affiliations with other International or regional firms.

5.3. EVALUATION

Proposals meeting all the Mandatory criteria will be evaluated by a Tender Committee and in order to receive full consideration, Proposals must meet the desired criteria.
