The Islamic Republic of Afghanistan Cricket Board has received a grant from International Cricket Council (ICC) toward the cost of Afghanistan Cricket Board and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this grant to payments under the contract for the sub project packages/lots given in para 3 below.

The Afghanistan Cricket Board now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for procurement of Fuel and Cooking Gas, the offered price should be valid for one month for next month ACB will collect quotation from selected vendors and it will be valid for upcoming month by signing contract amendment.
