Scope of Work (SOW)

Non-Clinical Waste Collection, Transportation and Disposal Services

Location: University Road, Ali Abad, Kabul, Afghanistan

1. **Scope of Work:** The contractor shall be responsible for collecting and moving the non-clinical waste as per the client's request and vacating and disposing of it at the designated area specified by the Kabul Municipality or any other government entity. In case of any wrong conduct by the contractor, all the responsibilities shall be on the contractor's account. The contractor shall ensure to provide the suitable vehicle for the collection of waste as per the protocols applied by the Kabul municipality or any other government entity.

2. **Nonclinical waste includes:**
 - 2.1 Administrative and office waste: paper, newspapers, magazines, files, packaging materials, cardboard.
 - 2.2 Food and cafeteria waste: leftover food, vegetable peels, disposable food containers.
 - 2.3 Garden and landscaping waste: grass clippings, leaves, branches.
 - 2.4 General cleaning waste: dust, debris, sweepings.
 - 2.5 Recyclables: plastics, bottles, cans, glass, metals.
 - 2.6 Non-infectious PPE or supplies: unused gloves, masks, packaging from medical supplies (not contaminated).
 - 2.7 Miscellaneous domestic-type waste: sandwich wrappers, drink cans, plastic bags.

3. **Contractor's Responsibility:** The Contractor shall be fully responsible for the acts, omissions, negligence, and misconduct of its employees, workers, agents, and representatives during the performance of the services. Any damage caused to FMIC property, equipment, facilities, or any third-party property by the Contractor or its personnel shall be repaired, replaced, or restored by the Contractor at its own cost and to the satisfaction of FMIC.

The Contractor shall be solely liable for any injury, illness, death, loss, claim, or damage arising from the performance of the services due to the negligence, misconduct, or failure of the Contractor, its employees, workers, agents, or representatives to comply with applicable laws, regulations, or safety requirements. The Contractor shall bear all associated costs, including medical expenses, compensation, legal liabilities, and other related expenses, and shall indemnify and hold harmless FMIC from any resulting claims, demands, actions, or liabilities.

4. **Work Schedule:** The contractor will collect and move the waste from the client's premises daily or as per the request of the client.
